## Community Learning Center Offers Free Adult Basic Education, GED, and ESOL Classes

Community Learning Center offers free classes in Adult Basic Education (ABE), General Educational Development (GED) Preparation, and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL).

Below is CLC's 2007-2008 class schedule, beginning September 10 and continuing through mid-June. New and returning students should go to the first session of the class of their choice, and plan to stay for the full three hours. There is no preregistration.

CLC also offers no-cost Distance Learning for ABE/GED learners. Distance learners study outside the classroom and communicate with a teacher by telephone, e-mail, and postal mail. With the teacher's guidance, the student uses the Internet, books, videos, and other materials. Distance learners need a quiet place to study for at least three hours each week.

An adult literacy program founded in 1987, Community Learning Center strives to help adults develop literacy, math, and life skills, using a supportive and holistic approach, so that they can realize their fullest potential at home, in the workplace, and in the community.
